









## Conservation of Tangible and Intangible Heritages

 LMC feels proud to honor Mr.
 Satya Mohan
 Joshi as a living legendry person. In the postal history of Nepal this is the first time that a postage stamp was issued during the lifetime of a Nepalese luminary DR SATYA MOHAN JOSHI

President Bidya Devi Bhandari affixed the first day cancellation mark today at Rastriya Bhawan on a postage stamp showing a picture of the most respectable centenarian Dr Satya Mohan Joshi.

Satya Mohan Joshi (1919) is a national cultural icon, a living doyen of Nepali history and culture and litterateur of the century. He had made an immense contribution to Nepali culture, history, and literature.

His early education was at home, and he later enrolled at Durbar High School in Kathmandu. He completed his bachelor's degree at Tri Chandra College.

He joined government service in 1944 and became the first director of the Archeological and Cultural Department in 1959. He established the Rashtriya Naachghar – National Theatre in

Kathmandu, Archeological Garden in Patan, Archeological Museum in Taulihawa, and the National Painting Museum in Bhaktapur.


After the political change in 1960, he resigned from service and went to China to teach Nepali at the Peking Broadcasting Institute for five years. During his stay in China, he researched Arniko, who had gone to China in 1260.

He was awarded the Madan Puraskar three times for his work: Hamro Lok Sanskriti (1956), Nepali Rashtriya Mudra (1957), and Karnali Lok Sanskriti (1971). He is also awarded Shrestha Sirpa for his outstanding book Jayaprakash, an epic in Nepal Bhasa (Newari). He has published more than 60 books on culture, literature, history, music, drama. Other publications include Kalakar Arniko, Sunkhesari, Majipa Lakhe, Charumati, Bagh Bhairab, Mrityu Ek Prasna, and Maharshi Yagyabalkya.

After receiving the Madan Puraskar, he started collecting folk songs, folk tales, folk riddle, and folk lifestyles and studied their development.

In honor of Joshi's 100th birth anniversary in May 2019, the Nepal Rastra Bank issued three coins of denominations Rs 100, Rs 1,000 and Rs 2,500 in September 2019.

He received the Tribhuwan Pragya Puraskar in 2057 BS for his contribution to culture. He is decorated with the 'Suprabala Gorkha Dakshin Bahu', 'Trishaktipatta', the 'Adikabi Bhanubhakta Puraskar, the 'Ujjwal Kritiman Rashtradeep' among other medals and decorations.





# Issues related to Engineers at Local level

- Career concern( Provincial act)
- Multi disciplinary job nature. Different than Govt. Unilateral Functional Organizations.
- Capacity Building Low motivation due to work load, Learning process is slow
- Working at local level is not only technical but also social. Knowledge of political connectivity of elected people to keep in mind sometimes easy becomes to solve the problems.
- Enhancement of professional ethics and integrity is always concern. (town is small)
- Pressure job, if can't deal properly
- Personality development is a concern.
- Plan your job not to make the job pending( reduces complains)
- Low moral on project procurement, supervision, Quality control . (time /Cost/quality)
- Not following SOP/ proper documentation/ rate analysis/ big comment of auditor.
- Threats and leave.
- Pressure group for donation.
- Harmony and team work within organization. Sometimes Diverging.
